## Terms and conditions for activities organised by the Honours College Social Association (HCSA)

- 1. Participation in activities either fully or partly organised by HCSA is entirely at the participant's own risk, neither the board nor the organising committee will accept any liability for lost or stolen properties of the participant.
- 2. Participants are always obliged to follow instructions of members of the board of HCSA or of the organising party of an activity.
- 3. Participants are always fully responsible for their own behaviour. This responsibility remains in force even if the participant is under the influence of alcohol, drugs or comparable substances.
- 4. HCSA does not accept any liability resulting from (improper) use of alcohol, drugs or comparable substances.
- 5. It is forbidden to take illegal substances to activities either fully or partly organised by HCSA. Behaviour not accordance with this rule can result in the immediate removal from the activity. Costs of this removal will be paid by the participant concerned.
- 6. HCSA is not responsible for any damages occurring as a result of behaviour by participants. By damages are meant material damages, non-material damages and injuries.
- 7. When a participant causes damage, this participant can be removed from the activity. The participant concerned will be fully liable for costs occurring as a result of the damage caused by him/her.
- 8. Withdrawal from this activity within 2 days before the start of the activity will result the obligation to pay the entrance fee, since a third party is involved. This fee should be transferred to the HCSA within two weeks after the activity.
